MSC FLAMINIA expected to reach German waters tomorrow

## Fact-finding teams of CCME ready for operation



The Analytical Task Force Germany (ATF), a representative of the Germanischer Lloyd, a fire fighting unit and further specialists of the CCME are on board of the multi-purpose vessel NEUWERK since this morning. Around noon, the vessel left Cuxhaven with altogether 17 experts and is now steering for the towing train with the MSC FLAMINIA.

The operational forces have the task to reassess the condition of the vessel and the cargo. This is done in close cooperation with the 13 experts of the shipping company and the salvage company that were on board of the MSC FLAMINIA during the passage.

The results of this second fact finding are assessed together with the casualty staff in Cuxhaven, thereafter the CCME decides on further proceedings.
