MSC FLAMINIA is in German waters

## **MSC FLAMINIA allowed to enter Wilhelmshaven**



In the course of the day, the towing train with the MSC FLAMINIA has continued its voyage in direction of the Deep Water Road. Given that the towing train keeps its speed of 3.5 knots, it will reach the zone of the Deep Water Road around 9.30 pm. The MSC FLAMINIA will not anchor there, but will be kept in position by tugs.

During the passage through the German territorial waters members of the second fact-finding team consistently went on board of the MSC FLAMINIA and took air, water and swipe samples. They also checked the stability of the vessel and the tightness of the hull. The results are on hand at the casualty staff, the towing train is allowed to enter Wilhelmshaven tomorrow.
