MSC FLAMINIA finishes towing voyage

MSC FLAMINIA safe in Jade-Weser-Port



The MSC FLAMINIA has just (5.45 pm) berthed at the quay of the Jade-Weser-Port in Wilhelmshaven.

This morning around 8.00 am the towing train with the MSC FLAMINIA had left the Deep Water Road and moved quickly to Wilhelmshaven. The passage proceeded smoothly. In front of the quay the damaged container vessel was turned and its bow is now facing the sea (Jade outbound).

In the coming days further investigations on board the MSC FLAMINIA are taking place for health and safety reasons. When this is done, the public prosecution department will search for the missing seafarer and conduct their investigations. After that, the unloading of the vessel can start.
